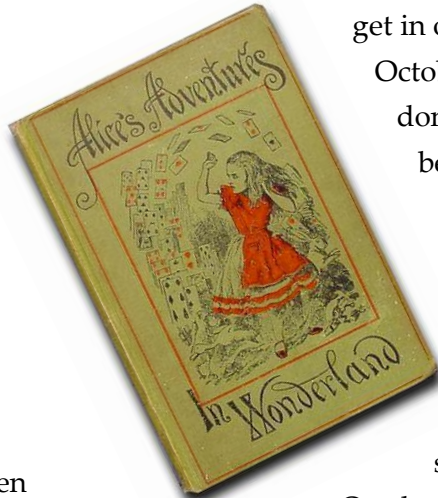
*“Take a good **book** to bed with you—**books** do not **snore**.”*

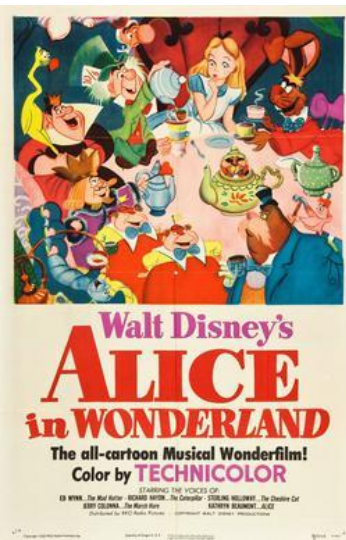
Everyone (whether at the Center or at Home) that wears a costume gets a prize! So, start planning your Mad Hatter costume or perhaps you are more of a
